

Courtyard construction to begin May 10
North Entrance and north parking lot to close for 60 days during construction



Fact Sheet

Construction on courtyard #5 – one of the two rehabilitation courtyards at PRHC will begin on Monday, May 10. It is expected to take about 60 days to complete. This courtyard is on the northwest side of the building and its entrance is close to A2 and Outpatient Rehabilitation.

North Entrance to close during construction

The North Entrance will close on May 10, and will remain closed throughout the construction for safety and construction access to the courtyard. The north parking lot (14 spaces) will also be closed.

Patients and visitors to PRHC may use the Main Entrance or the South Entrance as alternatives. Volunteer wayfinders are available at the Main Entrance between 7 a.m. and 8 p.m. to assist, and additional directional signage will be posted.

We apologize for any inconvenience the closure will cause.

Access to A2 and Outpatient Rehab

The main hallway on the second floor just inside the North Entrance will be inaccessible, except in emergency situations. A bank of pay phones located there will also be out of service.

Physicians, staff, volunteers and visitors should note the following:

- Access to A2 will be via B2 – clear directional signage will be in place.
- Access to Outpatient Rehab will be via the hallway by Hospitality Services and SPD – clear directional signage will be in place.

Background

The courtyard will be an extension of indoor treatment space for our rehabilitation patients, as well as aesthetically pleasing for all those in the hospital. Funding for the completion of this courtyard comes from PRHC Foundation donors, including the Festival of Trees and a bequest from a patient who spent time in the hospital. These generous gifts were intended specifically for this project – to enhance our healing environment. An RFP (Request for Proposals) for the completion of the second rehabilitation courtyard will be issued in the coming weeks. The remaining three courtyards will be completed as funding becomes available through donors to the Foundation.
