Hospital CEO and Board members to present draft HIP to the public at locations in Peterborough, Lakefield and Millbrook

Peterborough, ON: Peterborough Regional Health Centre President and CEO Ken Tremblay, along with members of the hospital’s Board of Directors, will present a draft of its Hospital Improvement Plan (HIP) at public information sessions to begin later on this month.

PRHC is required to present a HIP to the CE LHIN Board of Directors for approval on July 20. The HIP will outline PRHC’s plan to be in a balanced or surplus position by March 31, 2012.

The sessions will include a presentation, a short survey, and some roundtable discussion.
