The Opportunity

The PRHC Hospitalist Program is a dynamic and evolving service that cares for approximately 160 in-patients daily, in the areas of Acute Care, Rehab, Complex Continuing Care and Psychiatry. The Program benefits from a multi-disciplinary approach to care with excellent support from specialty services in the Hospital. Hospitalists carry a caseload of approximately 18 acute patients and follow these patients from admission to discharge. Hospitalists also rotate on-call shift coverage. Competitive compensation package available.

PRHC General Internal Medicine (GIM) program is supported through the Hospitalists program and offers a unique

opportunity where physicians provide consultation support to medically complex patients throughout the hospital. This unique model functions strictly as a consultation service is made possible because of our robust Hospitalist Program. Outside the wards internal medicine cares for patients in Perioperative surgical services, Perioperative clinics and the General Internal Medicine (GIM) Clinic. Our GIM clinic aims to provide urgent follow-up for patients with acute medical concerns, such as those who are discharged from hospital or the Emergency Department. With the hiring of two new internists the GIM program will continue to grow to support the needs of the hospital and community of Peterborough. Remuneration is fee-for-service OHIP billings.
