Peterborough Regional Health Centre's (PRHC) Hospitalist Program is recruiting Full, Part Time and Locum Hospitalists (Family Medicine or Internal Medicine trained) to join our wonderful team!

- · Hospitalists are responsible for covering approximately 20 patients per day from acute medical/surgical and rehab/ALC patients.
- · Hospitalists are well supported by specialty colleagues (named below). Intensivists and Cardiologists support the ICU/Telemetry Units.
- · Competitive daily stipend, HOCC for after hours call and fee for service billings.
- · Collaborative and collegial team with mentorship provided.
- · Comprehensive team-based approach, including support from NPs and allied health.
