Cardiology Elective Opportunity: Residents and Medical Students

Elective length: 2 to 4 weeks

Life in smaller communities offers a unique and enriching perspective on healthcare. As part of this elective, you will have the chance to experience diverse working environments, balancing community-based care with inpatient MRP and consultative services at Peterborough Regional Health Centre (PRHC).

This is the perfect time to explore the opportunity to complete an elective at PRHC.

Peterborough Regional Health Centre (PRHC) is a hub for advanced cardiac care in central Ontario, serving as a Regional Cardiac Centre of Excellence for five partner hospitals: Campbellford Memorial Hospital, Haliburton Highlands Health Services, Northumberland Hills Hospital, Ross Memorial, and Quinte Health – Bancroft.

The cardiac program is supported by the on-site regional nephrology and hemodialysis program, vascular surgery and a Level 3 ICU. PRHC serves a catchment population of over 300,000. We have recently been established as a level 3 trauma centre and offer extensive in-house consulting services.

You will work 1:1 with a cardiologist preceptor during your rotation; learning objectives can be tailored to your rotation goals and level of training.

Learning Objectives

- Experience working in a busy community Regional Cardiology Program, honing clinical judgement and critical skills managing complex cardiology patients in a fully equipped Coronary Care Unit and Cardiology Telemetry Unit.
- Work in a team structure providing cardiology consultative services to PRHC's busy Emergency Department as well as to our five (5) regional referring hospitals.
- Engage in multidisciplinary, nursing-supported Regional Chest Pain, Rapid Access, and Heart Function clinics, gaining experience in outpatient management of ischemic heart disease, heart failure, arrhythmias and complex cardiac patients across the continuum of care.
- Participate in a full spectrum of cardiac diagnostic testing, including stress testing, stress echocardiography, transthoracic echocardiography, Holter monitoring, and nuclear cardiology, with an emphasis on appropriate test selection, interpretation, and integration into patient care.

- The elective can be tailored to a fellows interests and could include comprehensive exposure to advanced imaging modalities, including transesophageal echocardiography or exposure to diagnostic coronary angiography and percutaneous coronary intervention

Rural Ontario Medical Program (ROMP)

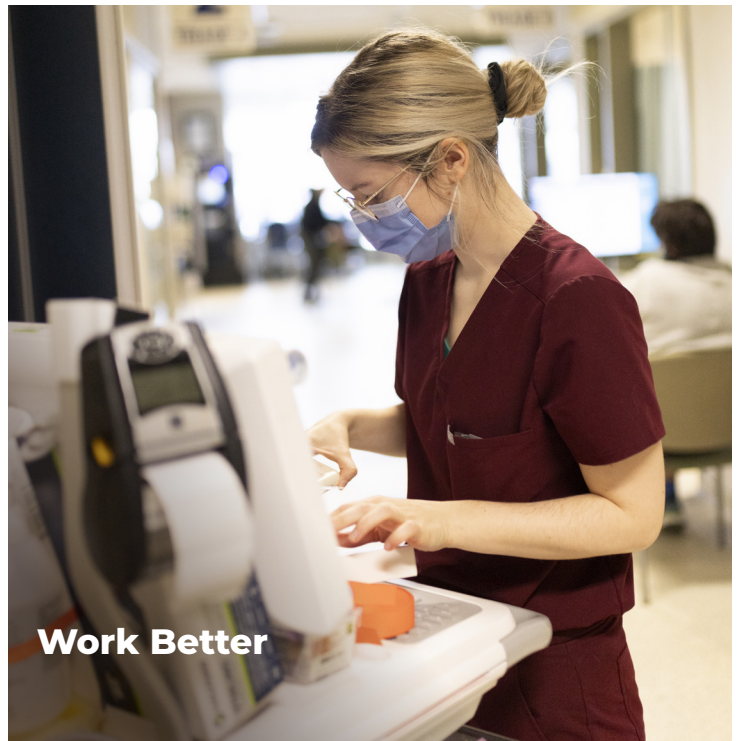

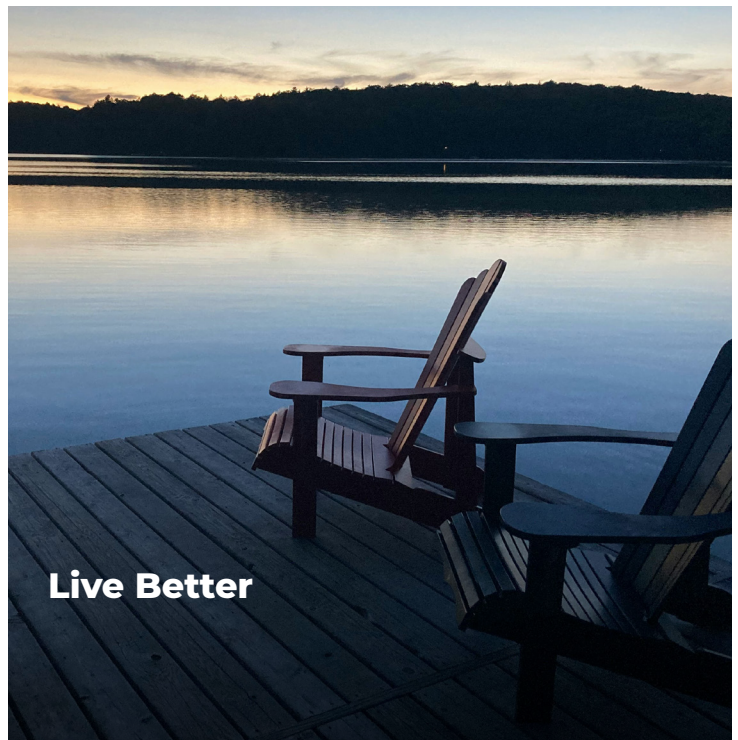
